





I hope everyone had a nice Thanksgiving, and welcome to a new liturgical year!

Today, Nov 28, marks the first Sunday of Advent! Advent means 'arrival'/coming in Latin. This is the coming of Jesus into the world. Christians use the four Sundays and weeks of Advent to prepare and remember the real meaning of Christmas. Many families use Advent calendars and Advent wreaths to count down the days and weeks to the Birth of Christ.

On Sunday, December 5th, we welcome all our 8th Grade Academy and Faith Formation students preparing for Confirmation as well as our RCITeen Yr 2 students to the 9:30am Mass. A meeting will take place in the church basement after the Mass to discuss important steps leading to Confirmation, which is only a few months away. **ONLY one parent** should accompany each student to the church basement due to space limitations

<u>Covid-19 safety reminders:</u> Masks are required. Social distancing and no physical contact are strongly recommended!

When Our Blessed Mother appeared to Saint Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes in 1858 she told her, "I am the Immaculate Conception."
