





We have officially entered the holiday season!


We were very excited to have our annual Christmas Boutique return. On December 2nd and 3rd, students had an opportunity to do some holiday shopping for their family and friends.

FAITH FORMATION CORNER....

Today marks the second Sunday of Advent! The second purple candle of the Advent wreath is also lit on this day. The purple candles represent the prayers, penance, and charitable works undertaken during this season.

Today we also welcome all our 8th Grade Academy and Faith Formation students preparing for Confirmation as well as our RCITeen Yr 2 students to the 9:30 AM mass. A brief meeting will take place in the church basement after the mass to discuss important steps leading to Confirmation, which is only a few months away. **ONLY one parent** should accompany each student to the church basement due to space limitations.

Confirmation "yellow forms" which are the Candidate Information forms, Sponsor Letters of Testimony and Intent (and proof of confirmation) will be collected in addition to confirmation prayers for the Confirmation prayers booklet.

Covid-19 safety reminders: Masks are high encouraged, social distancing to the extent possible and no physical contact.

On Wednesday, December 8th, we celebrate The Solemnity of The Immaculate Conception of The Blessed Virgin Mary. This Holy Day of Obligation celebrates Mary's conception in the womb of Saint Anne without the stain of original sin. When Our Blessed Mother appeared to Saint Bernadette Soubirous at Lourdes in 1858 she told her, "I am the Immaculate Conception."
