



WHAT TO DO WITH OLD SACRAMENTALS

When your rosary breaks or your crucifix falls apart, what to do? What should

be done with these holy objects?

Sacramentals are sacred signs and provide for us grace (spiritual help) through the intercession of the Church. They can be any number of religious items that have been blessed by a priest or deacon — a rosary, medal, scapular, crucifix, or even a candle.

Catholics are instructed to dispose of old sacramentals in a way that shows due reverence. All sacramentals can be either burned and buried or buried as they are in order to properly dispose of them. This type of disposal honors their sacred purpose and returns them to the earth in a dignified way. If a person is unable to do either, the sacramental may be dropped off at the rectory and someone on staff can take care of it.

By treating sacramentals with respect, we recognize & honor the heavenly blessing that was placed on the object.

Should you wish to dispose of palms blessed on Palm Sunday they should also be disposed of in the same way – you may bury them or burn them and spread the ashes outside.

I am happy to announce that the last two murals on the Church ceiling on either side of the choir loft have been completed and installed. The right mural is loving dedicated to the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville, NY for their Christ-like presence to our parish and service in our school. Here is the official statement provided by the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville.

"On January 23rd at the 11:30am Mass, Sacred Heart Church in Glendale will celebrate and bless a new mural that commemorates the longtime contribution of the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville (The Order of Preachers) to the parish!

The Sisters founded and served the parish school (now Sacred Heart Academy) beginning in 1941 and before that taught Sunday school classes there. Over the years, MORE THAN ONE HUNDRED SISTERS have lived or ministered there. They have done it all: teaching and administering at the school, leading faith formation, serving as Eucharistic ministers, offering piano lessons and more! Their presence continues even today. Six Sisters live at the convent: Ann Kohlhaupt, Barbara Kradick, Jeanne Elain Matullo, Eva Mazzetta, Patricia McCann and Judy Marie Olsen.

'We are overjoyed that the parish of Sacred Heart in Glendale is celebrating the Dominican Sisters of Amityville and our more than 80-year history serving the school and parish there,' said Sister Peggy McVetty, the Prioress of the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville.

'On behalf of all our members, we likewise celebrate the good people of this parish whose faith and witness have challenged us to be more authentic in our preaching. Special thanks to the artists who allowed our legacy of preaching to remain so vivid!'

The artwork is part of a larger mural project initiated by the Pastor, Father Fred Marano. This part of the mural project was commissioned by parishioner Rosemary Lazenby who has a warm love and appreciation for the Sisters! The mural was painted by wife/husband team Ginger Andro/Chuck Glicksman and their company True Faux Studio."
