

Having been imprisoned and awaiting martyrdom, along with the other Christians, he comforted them, encouraged them, and in many cases witnessed the marriages of couples who were imprisoned together. Some of his letters were secretly sent from the prison to his loved ones to explain what he and the others were enduring during their time there. The letters were inspiring and often gave the readers' instruction on the Christian Faith and how to be faithful and courageous. He always signed his letters "Your Valentine".



Christians throughout the world should always remember that this is SAINT Valentine's Day. He is not a chubby little cherub angel shooting love arrows like Cupid as the secular world misunderstands him. It truly is a wonderful day to celebrate the gift of Love in our lives. He is a martyr of the Church who gives us a great example of sacrificial love for Christ and one another.


