### Lenten Schedule



#### ASH WEDNESDAY MARCH 2ND

Ashes will be distributed during the Masses at 8:30am and 7:30pm and the 3:30pm Prayer

Service. Ashes will also be distributed, to those who are not comfortable going into the Church, or do not wish to attend Mass, inside the vestibule of the Church from 8:00-8:30am, from 3:00-3:30pm. and 7:00-7:30 pm.

All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All faithful (between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals except water. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

#### PREPARE THROUGH PRAYER MISSION

During the season of Lent on Monday, March 7<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, March 8<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday, March 9<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm in the Church, Sacred Heart Parish will sponsor a Lenten "Mission" (a three-night mini retreat) "Prepare Through Prayer."

The mission will be preached by Fr. Chris Bethge (born and raised in Sacred Heart Parish!) Fr. Chris is the Vocation Director of the Diocese of Brooklyn and faculty member at Cathedral Prep School and Seminary.
