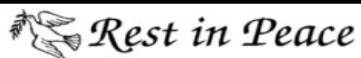

The St. Vincent De Paul group will **NOT** meet during the month of April.

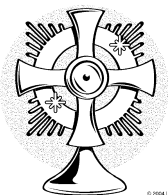

We hope you will join the parish in acknowledging that you, the newly confirmed, have completed the Christian initiation.

On Sunday, April 3rd at the 9:30 AM MASS we also welcome our Grade 2 Academy and Faith Formation families who are preparing for the Sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist. 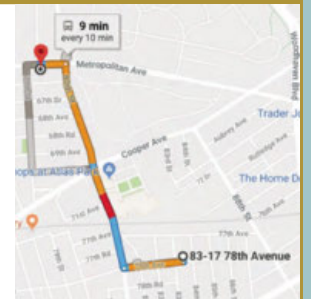
