

Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday is the 6th and last Sunday of Lent and the beginning of Holy Week. It marks the celebration of the solemn entry of Christ into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday is known as such because the faithful receive palm branches which we use to reenact Christ's arrival in Jerusalem. In the Gospels, Jesus entered Jerusalem riding on a young donkey and to the lavish praise of the townspeople who threw clothes and palm or small branches, in front of Him as a sign of homage.

Palm branches have long been widely recognized as a symbol of peace and victory. The use of a donkey instead of a horse is symbolic; it represents the humble arrival of someone in peace, as opposed to arriving on a steed in war.

During Palm Sunday Mass, palms are distributed which are then blessed. Because the palms are blessed, they may not be discarded as trash. The colors of the Mass on Palm Sunday are red, symbolizing the redemption in blood that Christ paid for the world!

Palms will be distributed and blessed at all the Masses, next weekend, April 9th & 10th.




