



ASCENSION THURSDAY, MAY 26th

The Ascension of the Lord is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be held on Wednesday, May 25th (the eve of) at 7:30 p.m. and on Thursday, May 26th at 8:30 a.m.

The Feast of the Ascension is celebrated the fortieth day after Easter and commemorates the Ascension of Christ into heaven. The terms used in the West, "ascensio" and occasionally, "ascensa," signify that Christ was raised up by His own powers, thus completing the work of our redemption.

Tradition designates Mount Olivet near Bethany as the place where Christ left the earth. The observance of this feast is of great antiquity. St. Augustine says that it is of Apostolic origin. Representations of the mystery are found in diptychs and frescoes dating as early as the fifth century. Certain customs were connected with the liturgy of this feast such as the blessing of beans and grapes, the extinction of the paschal candle and the triumphal processions with torches and banners outside the churches to commemorate the entry of Christ into heaven.


