



In 1907, Anna Jarvis held a private and the first Mother's Day celebration in memory of her mother, Ann Jarvis, in Grafton, West Virginia. She established "Mother's Day Work Clubs" to improve health and cleanliness in the area where she lived. She campaigned to make Mother's Day more widely recognized. In 1908, she arranged a service in the Andrew's Methodist Episcopal Church in Grafton, West Virginia which was attended by 407 children and their mothers. The church has now become the International Mother's Day Shrine. Though Mother's Day has become a day recognizing mothers' and mother figures' roles, the secular world has created a message that motherhood is something to be avoided. In fact, for some, the terms mother and maternal should be deleted from the English language. As Catholics, however, we are not to be discouraged. Rather, as a Church, we need to encourage mothers and maternal figures and show them their job is necessary and perhaps the most critical ministry! God bless our mothers and all women serving in maternal roles.
