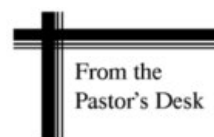

THE SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

The Solemnity of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is this **Friday, June 24th**. There will be a special Mass at 8:30 am, and will be celebrated by our very own Bishop of the Brooklyn Diocese, Bishop Robert Brennan. On this (our Patronal) feast day we remember all past & present Parishioners, Priests and Deacons, Sisters of St. Dominic, Church and School Staff and Alumni of Sacred Heart Parish.

A small reception will be held with Bishop Brennan following the Mass. Please join us to celebrate and welcome Bishop Brennan to our Parish and our Diocese!

The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is a celebration that falls 19 days after Pentecost on a Friday. The first Feast of the Sacred Heart was celebrated on August 31, 1670, in Rennes, France through the efforts of Fr. Jean Eudes (1602-1680). From Rennes, the devotion spread, but it took the visions of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque (1647-1690) for the devotion to become universal.

In all of these visions, in which Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary, the Sacred Heart of Jesus played a central role. The “great apparition,” which took place on June 16, 1675, during the octave of the Feast of Corpus Christi, is the source of the modern Feast of the Sacred Heart. In that vision, Christ asked St. Margaret Mary to request that the Feast of the Sacred Heart be celebrated on the Friday after the octave (or eighth day) of the Feast of Corpus Christi in reparation for the ingratitude of men for the sacrifice that Christ had made for them. The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents not simply His physical heart but His love for all mankind. The devotion became quite popular after St. Margaret Mary’s death in 1690, but because the Church initially had doubts about the validity of St. Margaret Mary’s visions, it wasn’t until 1765 that the feast was celebrated officially in France. Almost 100 years later in 1865, Pope Pius IX, at the request of the French bishops, extended the feast to the universal Church. It is celebrated on the day requested by our Lord—the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi or 19 days after Pentecost Sunday.

Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us!

THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ celebrates the Real Presence of Jesus Christ, in the Holy Eucharist—Body, Blood and Divinity. It is traditionally celebrated following the solemnity of the Holy Trinity. The feast dates to the Middle Ages and originated with a visionary nun and a Eucharistic miracle. In 1263 a German Priest, Fr. Peter of Prague, made a pilgrimage to Rome. He stopped in Bolsena, Italy to celebrate Mass. At the time he was having doubts about the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. When he recited the prayer of consecration, blood started seeping from the consecrated host and onto the altar and corporal. The relics were placed in the cathedral of Orvieto, where they remain today. The Eucharist Miracle confirmed the visions given to St. Juliana (1193-1253). St. Juliana was a nun and mystic who had a series of visions in which she was instructed by Our Lord to work to establish a liturgical feast for the Holy Eucharist. After many years of trying, she finally convinced the bishop, the future Pope Urban IV, to create this special feast in honor of the Blessed Sacrament. Soon after her death, Pope Urban instituted Corpus Christi and celebrated it for the first time in Orvieto in 1264, a year after the Eucharistic Miracle in Bolsena.



Father’s Day is celebrated on the third Sunday in June every year. The history of this special day goes back to the first decade of the 20th century

with an influential woman called Sonora Smart Dodd. Sonora was one of six children raised by her widower father. This was uncommon at the time, as many widowers placed their children in the care of others or quickly married again. Sonora was inspired by the work of Anna Jarvis, who had pushed for Mother’s Day celebrations. Sonora felt that her father deserved recognition for what he had done. The first time Father’s Day was held in June was in 1910. Father’s Day was officially recognized as a holiday in 1972 by President Nixon. Some Latin and European countries celebrate Father’s Day on March 19th, the feast of St. Joseph. Joseph is the model of fatherhood. His faith and obedience to God inspired his devotion for his family.

On Father’s Day let us remember that we have been given a heritage of dedication and faithfulness from the fathers we encounter in the Bible (Abraham, Joseph of Galilee, Jairus) and from those men (fathers, grandfathers, uncles, godfathers, etc.) who today exemplify the best qualities of parenting.

MISSION WEEKEND

Next weekend, June 25th and 26th, Mr. Paul Franzetti of Damien House, will speak at all the Masses about his work for Damien House in Guayaquil, Ecuador. Damien House is a residential hospital that exists to provide care and help dispel the stigma of those affected by Hansen's Disease (Leprosy). Run on private donations Damien House provides round the clock care for over 30 in-house residents and free medical care for our 700 outpatients. Those who live at Damien House are unable to live independently due to complications from the disease or because the stigma prevents them from returning home. The spirit and will of its patients and staff is truly a miracle. Many of the patients live at Damien House because they are no longer welcome in society. However, if caught early, Hansen's Disease can be treated and completely cured. All of the residents at Damien House have been completely cured of the disease. Many are living with the secondary complications of the disease. Hansen's Disease is one of the oldest and most misunderstood disease of our world.

"To provide complete medical care for patients of Hansen's Disease... To help patients live a life of dignity and love no matter what their situation may be... To help patients return to living full lives... To provide public education, to dispel the myths regarding the disease, to allow earlier treatments, and to minimize complications..."

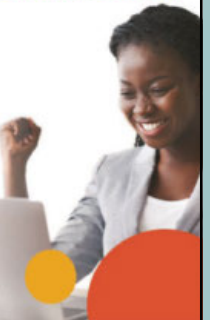

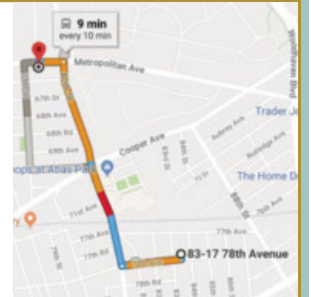
