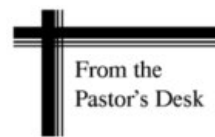

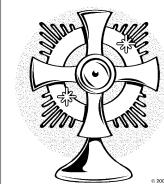

MISSION WEEKEND

This weekend, June 25th and 26th, Mr. Paul Franzetti of Damien House, will speak at all the Masses about his work for Damien House in Guayaquil, Ecuador.

Damien House is a residential hospital that exists to provide care and help dispel the stigma of those affected by Hansen's Disease (Leprosy). Run on private donations Damien House provides round the clock care for over 30 in-house residents and free medical care for our 700 out-patients. Those who live at Damien House are unable to live independently due to complications from the disease or because the stigma prevents them from returning home. The spirit and will of its patients and staff is truly a miracle. Many of the patients live at Damien House because they are no longer welcome in society. However, if caught early, Hansen's Disease can be treated and completely cured. All of the residents at Damien House have been completely cured of the disease. Many are living with the secondary complications of the disease Hansen's Disease is one of the oldest and most misunderstood disease of our world.

The ushers will be holding donation baskets as you leave Mass to help support Damien House. Thank you for your generosity!

First Friday Devotion

The Devotion to the Sacred Heart began in the 1670s when Jesus appeared multiple times to St. Margret Mary Alacoque, a Visitation nun in France. Through these visions, He told her how He wished to be honored with the symbol of His Heart asking for the faithful to make amends for any wrongdoing they had done, frequently take Communion, and observe the Holy Hour. In 1856, the devotion was added to the church calendar by Pope Pius IX. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is connected to our worship of Christ as God incarnate and is related to Christ's love for the human race. First Friday devotion offers reparation for the innumerable offenses committed against the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Devotees to the First Friday must do three things for 9 consecutive months on the First Friday of that month: 1) Attend Mass 2) Receive Communion 3) Go to confession within 8 days of the First Friday devotion
Our Lord made 12 promises to those devoted to His Heart:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.
2. I will give peace in their families.
3. I will console them in all their troubles.
4. They shall find in My Heart an assured refuge during life and especially at the hour of death.
5. I will pour abundant blessings on all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall speedily rise to great perfection.
9. I will bless the homes in which the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who propagate this devotion shall have their name written in My Heart, and it shall never be effaced.
12. The all-powerful love of My Heart will grant to all those who shall receive Communion on the first Friday of 9 consecutive months the grace of final repentance; they shall not die under My displeasure, nor without receiving the Sacraments; My Heart shall be their assured refuge at the last hour.

Sacred Heart Parish offers its parishioners a Holy Hour in honor of First Friday after the 8:30 am Mass. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 9:00 to 10:00 am concludes with Benediction. All are invited to honor the Sacred Heart of Jesus every first Friday. Come and receive the 12 graces promised by our Lord, Jesus Christ!

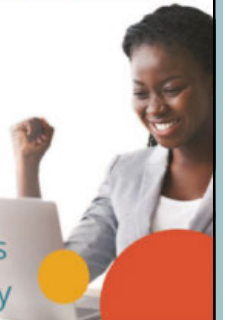

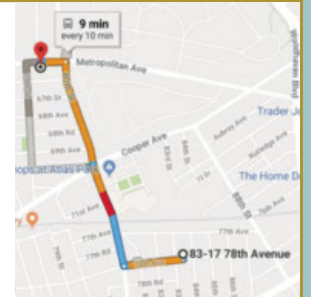
