



#### PENTECOST SUNDAY—June 5th

The word Pentecost is Greek and it means "50th day." Fifty days after Easter Sunday, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, their followers and the beginning of their earthly ministry to make disciples of all nations.

At Pentecost, the Apostles and their followers were gathered in a room. Jews from all over the world were gathered in Jerusalem. A great wind blew and a flame appeared as a tongue of fire, which split itself into many individual flames above the heads of all those present. The Holy Spirit came upon those gathered and they began to speak "in tongues." Despite the fact that many had no common language, they were perfectly able to understand one another. Three thousand people were baptized that day. This was the beginning of the Catholic Christian Church.

The symbols of Pentecost are the flame, wind and the dove which represent the Holy Spirit. The color of Pentecost is red and the priest wears red vestments on this day. *Come Holy Spirit fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love!*
