


The Parish Ministry Office will be closed from Friday, July 29th through Monday, September 5th. Our regular business hours will resume on Tuesday, September 6th.

TRANSFIGURATION — AUGUST 6th

The Transfiguration of Jesus is one of the key events in Jesus' life. He took three apostles—Peter, James and John—up to a high mountain to pray. As they were praying, His appearance changed, and His clothes became "dazzling white." At that point, Moses and Elijah appeared and spoke to the Lord about His upcoming death. A cloud overshadowed the group, and God the Father's voice came from the cloud saying, "This is my Son, my Chosen; listen to Him!"

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Christ's Transfiguration aims at strengthening the apostles' faith in anticipation of His passion. The ascent onto the "high mountain" prepares for the ascent to Calvary. The divine glory which was Christ's was allowed for a moment to shine through His human body.

WHAT TO DO WITH OLD SACRAMENTALS

When your rosary breaks or your crucifix falls apart, what to do? What should be done with these holy objects?

Sacramentals are sacred signs and provide for us grace (spiritual help) through the intercession of the Church. They can be any number of religious items that have been blessed by a priest or deacon — a rosary, medal, scapular, crucifix, or even a candle.

SACRAMENTALE

Catholics are instructed to dispose of old sacramentals in a way that shows due reverence. All sacramentals can be either burned and buried or buried as they are in order to properly dispose of them. This type of disposal honors their sacred purpose and returns them to the earth in a dignified way. If a person is unable to do either, the sacramental may be dropped off at the rectory and someone on staff can take care of it.

By treating sacramentals with respect, we recognize & honor the heavenly blessing that was placed on the object.

Should you wish to dispose of palms blessed on Palm Sunday they should also be disposed of in the same way – you may bury them or burn them and spread the ashes outside.

FORMED

FORMED, produced by the Augustine Institute, has come to Sacred Heart and is available without charge to all parishioners. All that is needed to visit the website is internet Access and an e-mail account.

FORMED is an on-line resource for adult and youth faith formation, prayer, sacramental preparation, and so much more. Recent presentations include videos on saints, prayer, spiritual development for men and women, daily Scripture reflections, things of interest for children, and many other topics.

The app can be downloaded very easily to your computer or ROKU and to your cell phone or iPad so that you can enjoy the presentations wherever you happen to be. To register on FORMED:




