


ST. GABRIEL SOCIETY **MIDDLE SCHOOL GROUP RETURNS!**

OUR LADY OF THE ROSARY-OCTOBER 7th

The Church celebrates the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary on October 7th. On this day, we celebrate the Holy League's defeat of the Ottoman Empire in the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. Even though the Turkish forces were very powerful, they were defeated by the Christians due to the intercession of Mary and the prayer of the Most Holy Rosary. Pope St. Pius V knew that Our Lady interceded for the Holy League, ensuring their victory. In fact, the day of the Battle of Lepanto, October 7, 1571, he saw the Blessed Mother in a vision and she revealed the victory to him.
