



MOST HOLY NAME OF MARY <u>SEPTEMBER 12th</u>

The Most Holy Name of Mary feast day honors Mary, the Mother of God, as blessed. It takes place each year on September 12th four days after the feast of the Birth of the Blessed Mother. The feast day encourages us all to pray for her intercession to deepen our love of Christ and our relationship with the Lord.

The Most Holy Name of Mary originated in Spain in the sixteenth century. In 1683, Pope Innocent XI extended the feast day to the universal Church and gave it the September 12th date. The date is significant because it marks a battle victory for Christian Europe against the Muslim Turks. The Christians prayed for the intercession of Mary throughout their long and arduous campaign before achieving victory. There is no better way to celebrate the Most Holy Name of Mary than by attending Mass, and pray the Rosary.

Catechetical Sunday will be celebrated on Sunday, September 18th at the 9:30 AM Mass. Please join our Academy and Faith Formation catechists to celebrate the work they do to spread the Good News of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On Wednesday, September 21st at 7 PM we invite our Faith Formation students (accompanied by parents) to join us for an Opening Mass to kick off our new school year. Please join us for this special Mass to be celebrated by Fr. Fred.

A Zoom meeting is scheduled for Thursday, September 29th at 7 PM for the PARENTS ONLY of children in Grades 5, 6, 7, and 8 to discuss the Diocese offering - Family Life. This is a separate offering by the Diocese and is NOT part of the My Catholic Faith Delivered online course.

Beginning the week of September 19th and continuing to the end of the month, My Catholic Faith Delivered logins will be released so students can sign into their classes and begin their coursework. Instruction will primarily take place at home, encouraging parents to journey with their children as they grow in faith through the online learning platform *My Catholic Faith Delivered*. Catechists can communicate with their classes through lesson threads and will be hosting Zoom meetings during the months of October, November, and December (one each month) to discuss the Rosary, Saints, and Advent/Christmas respectively.

Please pray that our 2022-2023 Faith Formation school year prepares our children to encounter Jesus and share in the graces and peace that only such an encounter can bring! EXALTATION OF THE CROSS SEPTEMBER 14th

The exaltation of the Cross honors Christ's Cross, an instrument made sacred by the Lord's offering of Himself upon it for our salvation. When we honor or exalt the Cross, Christians are primarily acknowledging Christ Himself (2nd Council of Nicaea). As well as celebrating the sacrifice of Jesus on the Cross, the feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross commemorates two historical events. The first is the discovery in 320 AD of the True Cross of Calvary and of the tomb of Christ by St. Helena, the mother of Emperor Constantine, which the Romans had buried under a Temple to Venus. The second is the dedication of a church on the site in 335 AD. Today this church, in continuous existence since then, is known as the Basilica of the Holy Sepulcher, and houses Calvary, the Tomb of Jesus and the cistern in which St. Helena found the instruments of the Passion, including the Cross.

The feast more than anything else, is a celebration and commemoration of God's greatest work: His salvific death on the Cross and His Resurrection through which death was defeated and the doors to Heaven opened.
