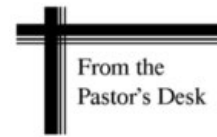

This past Sunday we held our first Level/Grade 2 class MASS which was followed by the first Proximate preparation meeting in the Church basement for all Faith Formation and Academy students and parents.

On Tuesday, October 18th, our catechists met with their students in our first Zoom meeting for Grades 1, 2, and 3 on the topic of the Rosary. We reminded our children that Mary asks us to pray our rosaries daily for peace in the world.

On Wednesday, October 19th at 7 PM, we held our virtual proximate preparation meeting for Level/Grade 8 and RCIA Teen Year 2 students. The topic presented was St. John Paul II's Theology of the Body followed by a meeting to discuss the requirements for the year ahead and preparation for Confirmation in 2023.

This Sunday, October 23rd, we welcome our Level/Grade 1 families to our 9:30 AM Mass followed by a meeting in the church basement to say hello to their Grade/Level 1 catechist.

On Tuesday, October 25th, our catechists will meet with their students in their first Zoom meeting for Grades 4, 5, 6 and 7 on the topic of the Rosary.

On Wednesday, October 26th, our Level/Grade 7 parents will participate in a Zoom meeting at 7 PM to discuss Investiture and the year ahead.

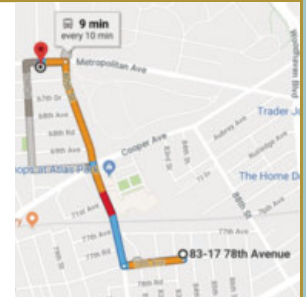
