

### SOLEMNITY OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST KING OF THE UNIVERSE NOVEMBER 20TH

Each year we celebrate Christ's sovereignty on the last Sunday of the liturgical year, the 34th Sunday in Ordinary Time. This year the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe is on November 20th. Pope Pius XI instituted the feast in 1925 in an effort to combat a rising trend toward godlessness and challenges to the Kingship of Christ. These challenges included the rise of atheism, attempts to exclude clergy input in the public discussions, attempts to remove the influence of God in the formation of laws and public policy, and the rise of secularism (sound familiar?). Pope Pius XI wanted to remind the nations that the Catholic Church remained more important than political realms. Originally, it was designated for late October, but Pope St. Paul VI changed it to the final Sunday of the liturgical year, which is the Sunday before the beginning of Advent. This corresponds well to the end of history when Christ returns as King, a subject which the liturgies of the first half of Advent will take up. Let us recall and be strengthened by the words of Pope Pius XI:

"While nations insult the Beloved Name of Our Redeemer by suppressing all mention of it in their conferences and parliaments, we must all the more loudly proclaim His kingly dignity and power, all the more universally affirm His rights!"
