



In 1531, the Blessed Mother appeared four times to St. Juan Diego asking for a church to be built in her honor. The last time she appeared to St. Juan, on December 12th, 1531, she arranged roses in his tilma, which

he took to the bishop. When he opened his cloak, the image of Our Lady of Guadalupe was miraculously pressed on the tilma. We therefore celebrate the feast day of Our Lady under the title Guadalupe on December 12th. It is preceded on December 9th by the feast of St. Juan Diego, who was canonized in 2002 by Pope St. John Paul II.

A special Mass will be celebrated on Monday, December 12th at 8:30 a.m. Come and offer blessed rose pedals as a symbol of your prayers to Our Blessed Mother.



On Saturday, December 10th, our Level/Grade 6, 7 and 8 Faith Formation students participated in Advent confessions.


On Tuesday, December 13th at 7 PM will be our Zoom meeting for Grades 4,5,6 and 7 on the topic of Advent and Christmas.
