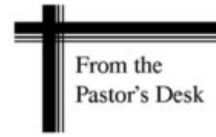
We will use the entrance to the Cronin Meeting Room on 84th Street. Numbers will be given out and intentions will be accepted for this six month period **ONLY**. Please note:

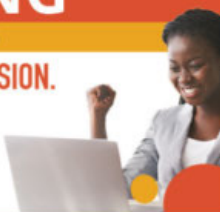

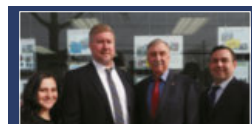

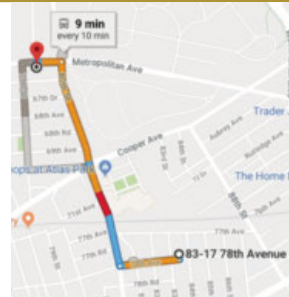
