We have reached our Goal!


Thank you to the 161 parish families who contributed to this year's Annual Catholic Appeal. We reached our goal of \$63,870. Your generosity is

EPIPHANY JANUARY 8TH

On the feast of the Epiphany, the Church celebrates the manifestation (epiphany) of Christ to the Nations in the persons of the Magi—also known as the Wise Men or the Three Kings. In

earlier times, this feast combined two other manifestations, that which took place at the Lord's Baptism, and that which took place in Cana at the Wedding feast. This is still the custom in Eastern Christianity. Although the date of the Epiphany on the General Calendar of the Church is January 6th, the United States and some other countries celebrate it the Sunday after January 1st so more Catholics can participate. Thus, in 2023 the Solemnity of the Epiphany is January 8th.

BAPTISM OF CHRIST JANUARY 9TH

This day commemorates the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by St. John the Baptist. On this occasion, Jesus entered into His ministry and acquired His first disciples. St. John proclaimed Christ the Lamb of God, whose way he had prepared, and the Triune nature of the Godhead was manifested.
