



<u>Feast of Saint Valentine</u> February 14th

One of the legends of St. Valentine, the Patron Saint of Pure (Chaste) Love, reveals that he was a priest of the 3rd century Christian Church in Rome. Having been imprisoned and

awaiting martyrdom, along with the other Christians, he comforted them, encouraged them, and in many cases witnessed the marriages of couples who were imprisoned together. Some of his letters were secretly sent from the prison to his loved ones to explain what he and the others were enduring during their time there. The letters were inspiring and often gave the readers' instruction on the Christian Faith and how to be faithful and courageous. He always signed his letters "Your Valentine".

Christians throughout the world should always remember that this is **SAINT** Valentine's Day. He is not a chubby little cherub angel shooting love arrows like Cupid as the secular world misunderstands him. It truly is a wonderful day to celebrate the gift of Love in our lives. He is a martyr of the Church who gives us a great example of sacrificial love for Christ and one another.





ASH WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 22ND

Ashes will be distributed during the Masses at 8:30am and 7:30pm and the 3:30pm Prayer Service. Ashes will also be distributed, to those who are not comfortable going into the Church,

or do not wish to attend Mass, inside the vestibule of the Church from 8:00-8:30am, from 3:00-3:30pm. and 7:00-7:30 pm.

All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All faithful (between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals except water. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

BRIDGE TO LIFE

In addition to your sacrificial offerings during Lent, Sacred Heart Parish will sponsor a Baby Bottle Campaign to help unwed mothers and those with unexpected pregnancies. Francesca from Bridge to Life will speak at all the Masses next weekend, February 18 & 19, about the Parish Lenten Baby Bottle Campaign. Baby bottles will be distributed after all the Masses that weekend.
