



#### SAINT PATRICK—MARCH 17TH



Patrick was born in 385 in Roman Britannia in the modern-day town of Dumbarton, Scotland. At the age of 16 he was captured by barbarian Irish pirates who took him inland and forced him to work as a farm laborer and shepherd. He suffered greatly at their hands. During his enslavement, Patrick's Christian faith galvanized and served to sustain him during the

dark years of captivity. After 6 years of imprisonment, Patrick had a dream in which he was shown an escape route to freedom. He successfully boke free from his captors and eventually traveled back to his homeland. There, he committed to his faith in earnest and became a priest. He felt tremendous mercy toward the people who kidnapped him. So he returned to Ireland with a mission of seeing pagan Ireland converted. The gospel drove Patrick to return to his oppressors that he might devote his life to their peaceful conversion and the cause of their salvation.
