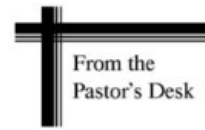
EASTER

The secularization of our holy days is just a reflection of the world around us. The Easter "bunny" and "coloring eggs" are fun traditions to do with children. However, our children primarily must understand the significance of Christ's Death and Resurrection. Easter ("springtime" in Old English) represents the fulfillment of God's promise to humankind and it is the most important holy day on the Christian calendar. If Christ had not risen from the dead, if He had died and not been resurrected, He would have been considered just another failed teacher, prophet or Rabbi. Christianity would have died with Christ. However, "...by being raised from the dead he was proved to be the mighty Son of God, with holy nature of God himself." (Romans 1:4)

As wonderful as those traditions are, Easter is more than "colored eggs" and "chocolates." It's not about the "bunny," it's about the Lamb!

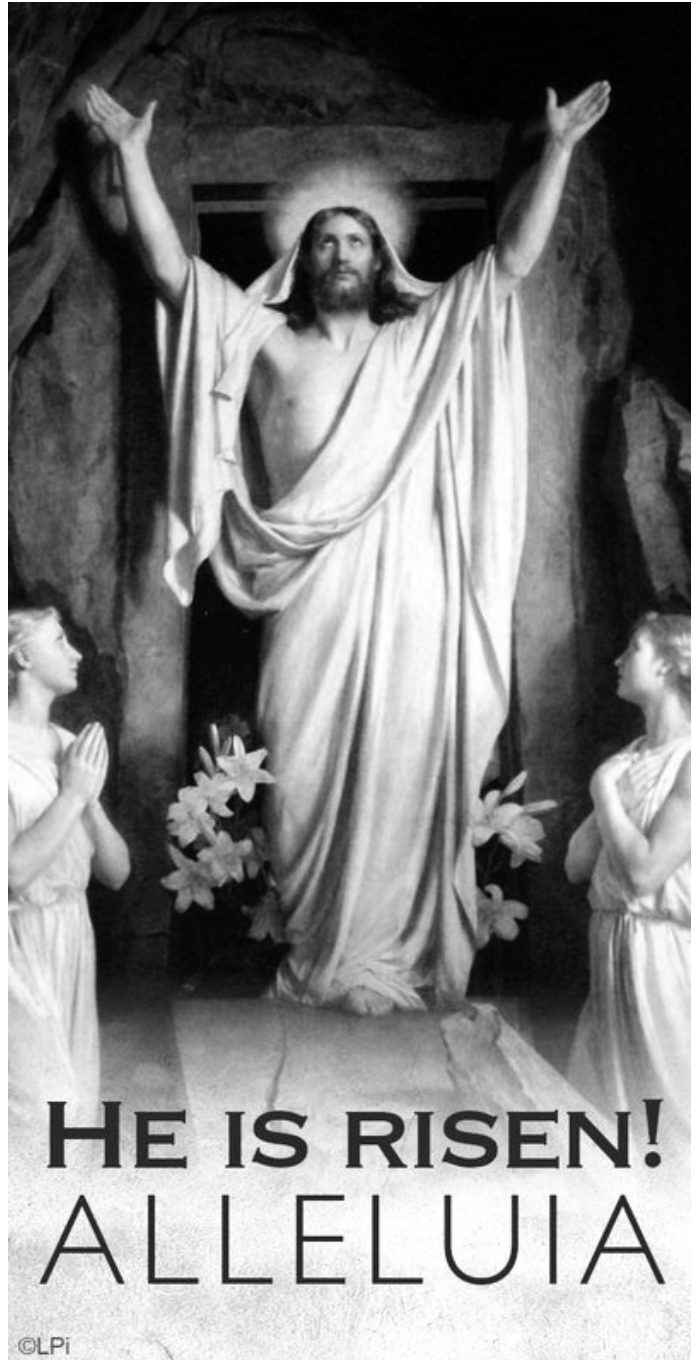

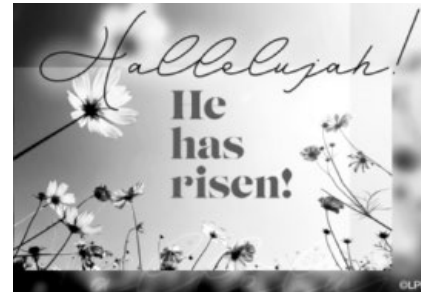
All our Faith Formation students enrolled in My Catholic Faith Delivered are encouraged to begin completing their coursework as May is approaching quickly!

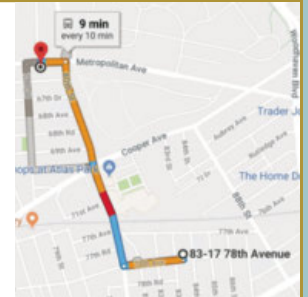
