





ASCENSION THURSDAY, MAY 18th

The Ascension of the Lord is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be held on Wednesday, May 17th (the eve of) at 7:00 p.m. and on Thursday, May 18th at 8:30 a.m.

The feast of the Ascension is celebrated the fortieth day after Easter and commemorates the Ascension of Christ into heaven. The terms used in the West, ascenso and occasionally, ascensa, signify that Christ was raised up by His own powers, thus completing the work of our redemption.

Tradition designates Mount Olivet near Bethany as the place where Christ left the earth. The observance of this feast is of great antiquity. St. Augustine says that it is of Apostolic origin. Representations of the mystery are found in diptychs and frescoes dating as early as the fifth century. Certain customs were connected with the liturgy of this feast such as the blessing of beans and grapes, the extinction of the paschal candle and the triumphal processions with torches and banners outside the churches to commemorate the entry of Christ into heaven.

MOTHERS' DAY—MAY 14TH

Though it's not on the Church's calendar, Mothers' Day is still one of the most important Sundays of the year. The official Mother's Day holiday arose in the 1900s as a result of the efforts of Anna Jarvis. Following her mother's death, Anna desired that there be a special day to honor the sacrifices mothers made for their children. With the financial support from John Wanamaker, a department store owner, Anna organized the first official Mothers' Day celebration at a Methodist church in West Virginia in May, 1908. On that same day, thousands of people attended a Mothers' Day event at one of the Wanamaker's stores in Philadelphia. Following the success of the first Mothers' Day, Anna persevered in her efforts to have Mothers' Day added to the national calendar. Finally, in 1914, President Woodrow Wilson signed a measure establishing the second Sunday in May as Mothers' Day. Ironically, as the holiday became more and more commercialized, Anna Jarvis spent the remainder of her life trying to have the holiday removed from the national calendar! On Mothers' Day let us thank God for the unique role that mothers, grandmothers, aunts, godmothers, etc. play in the lives of children and in the world and let us thank God for Mary, our spiritual mother who is always present and stands as our advocate of grace.
