ALL SAINTS / ALL SOULS DAY MASSES

Wednesday, November 1st is the Solemnity of All Saints. It is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be celebrated at 7:00pm on October 31st and 8:30am on November 1st..

Thursday, November 2nd is the Commemoration of All Souls. Masses will be offered for our dearly departed at 8:30am and 7:00pm. The names of the deceased of the past year will be read at the 7:00 pm Mass.

ALL SAINTS DAY—NOVEMBER 1ST

All Saints Day honors the saints in Heaven—those who have been recognized by the Church as saints, as well as those who have not been canonized. The feast was established in Rome as a result of the emperor's giving of the Pantheon (the Temple to all gods) to the Church and its dedication to St. Mary and all the Martyrs. The feast was originally on the date of the Pantheon's dedication, May 13, 609, and the date of an already existing feast in the East. It was later moved to its current date on the Roman calendar, where it is followed by the Commemoration of All Souls, that is those righteous dead being purified in Purgatory. Mary, the Mother of God, is the most honored Saint. She is in fact the Queen of Heaven and Queen of the Saints.


