



#### THANKSGIVING—NOVEMBER 23RD

Thanksgiving Day is celebrated on the fourth Thursday of November in the United States, as specified in a joint resolution passed by Congress in 1941 and a proclamation issued by President Franklin D. Roosevelt in 1942. Thanksgiving has historical roots in religious and cultural traditions, but it has long been celebrated as a secular holiday as well. In 1621, the Plymouth colonists and Wampanoag Indians shared an autumn harvest feast that is acknowledged as one of the first Thanksgiving celebrations in the colonies. The holiday continues to be a day for Americans to gather for a day of feasting and family. This year, begin Thanksgiving Day by attending Mass and prayerfully reflecting on giving thanks to God.

- The first Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade was held in 1924.
- •Canada celebrates Thanksgiving on 2nd Monday in October
- •Germany celebrates Thanksgiving on 1st Sunday in October.
- •Brazil celebrates Thanksgiving on the 4th Sunday in Nov.

Thank you to our 8th grade teacher and Youth Minister, Mr. Stamm and the St. Gabriel Society for helping to raise nearly \$4,000 for the construction of a water well for the villagers in Adzonkor, Ghana. They raised over 50% of the total cost of the project which was \$6,600.


