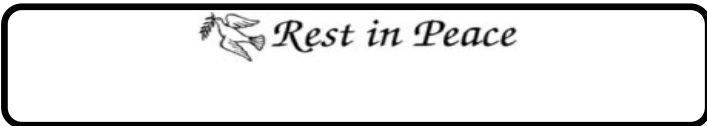

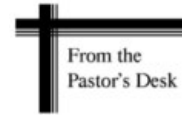

BAPTISM OF THE LORD—JANUARY 8TH

This day commemorates the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by St. John the Baptist. On the occasion, Jesus entered into His ministry and acquired His first disciples, St. John proclaimed Christ the Lamb of God whose way he had prepared, and the Triune nature of the Godhead was manifested. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that “immediately after Christ’s baptism by John, He was driven by the Spirit to spend time (40 days) in the desert without eating. At the end of this time, Satan tempted him three times. Jesus rebuffed these attacks, and the devil leaves him until an opportune time.”

“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased.”

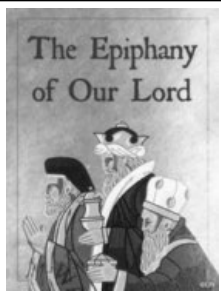

SOLEMNITY OF THE EPIPHANY JANUARY 7TH



On this feast, the Church celebrates the manifestation (epiphany) of Christ to the Nations (Gentiles) in the persons of the Magi –also known as the Wise Men or the Three Kings. In earlier times, this feast combined two other manifestations, that which took place at the Lord’s Baptism, and that which took place in Cana at the Wedding feast. This is still the custom in Eastern Christianity. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says “The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Savior of the world. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (magi) from the East...In the magi, representatives of the neighboring pagan religions, the Gospel sees the first-fruits of the nations, who welcome the good news of salvation through the Incarnation. The magi’s coming to Jerusalem in order to pay homage to the King of the Jews shows that they seek in Israel, in the messianic light of the star of David, the one who will be king of the nations...Their coming means that pagans can discover Jesus and worship him as Son of God and Savior of the world.”

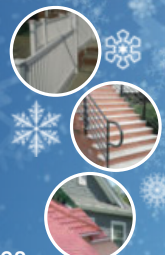

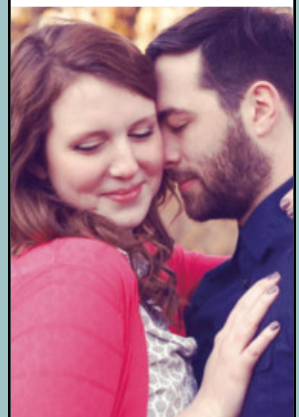

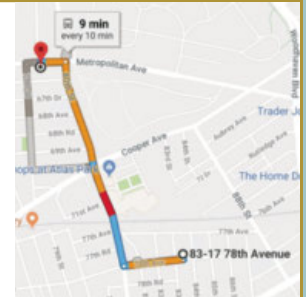
