

ASH WEDNESDAY FEBRUARY 14th

Ashes will be distributed during the Masses at 8:30am and 7:00pm and the 3:30pm Prayer Service. Ashes will also be distributed, to those who are not comfortable going into the



Church, or do not wish to attend Mass, inside the vestibule of the Church from 8:00-8:30am, from 3:00-3:30pm. and 6:30-7:00 pm.

All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All faithful (between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals except water. Light sustenance may also be taken



on two other occasions during the day.

LENTEN FAMILY CALENDARS are daily meditations and acts of charity for each day of Lent. These will be given out. Please take one per family.



LENTEN NAILS Take a nail on Ash Wednesday to remind you of Christ's suffering and return it on Good Friday.


