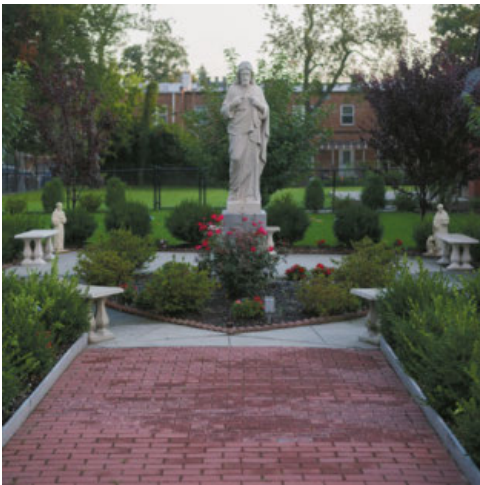

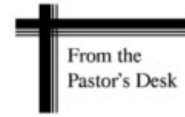

 Since our Church bells ring 3 times a day at 12 noon, 3pm(with instrumental music) and 6pm, and the sound brings, hope, joy & awareness of the presence of our Church in the neighborhood, we would like to offer that the bells be rung in memory of a loved one or for a special intention. Beginning the week of January 21st, this memorial is available for your consideration. The Bells will ring for 1 week (Sunday through Saturday) for your intentions. The donation is \$30.

ASH WEDNESDAY
FEBRUARY 14th
 Ashes will be distributed during the Masses at 8:30am and 7:00pm and the 3:30pm Prayer Service. Ashes will also be distributed, to those who are not comfortable going into the Church, or do not wish to attend Mass, inside the vestibule of the Church from 8:00-8:30am, from 3:00-3:30pm. and 6:30-7:00 pm.
 All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain totally from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. All faithful (between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive) are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This practice involves limiting oneself to a single full meal and avoiding food between meals except water. Light sustenance may also be taken on two other occasions during the day.

 **LENTEN FAMILY CALENDARS** are daily meditations and acts of charity for each day of Lent. These will be given out on Ash Wednesday.
LENTEN NAILS Take a nail on Ash Wednesday to remind you of Christ's suffering and return it on Good Friday.
DAILY MASS offered Monday to Saturday at 8:30 am.
SACRAMENT OF CONFESSION every Saturday from 3:30 to 4:30 pm. Confession will also be heard on Reconciliation Monday, March 25th from 4:00-5:30 pm and 6:30-8:00.
STATIONS OF THE CROSS will be held the Fridays during Lent at 7:00pm, beginning February 16th, in the Church. Each week a different set of Stations will be prayed written by different spiritual authors. Please come and walk the way of suffering with Jesus and one another.
