



## THE SOLEMNITY OF THE ANNUNCIATION APRIL 8TH

At that moment, the "Word became flesh and dwelt among us." (John 1:14) This is called the Incarnation.

During the Holy Hour, there will be Exposition of the Holy Eucharist,

Solemn Chanting of the Divine Mercy Chaplet, and Benediction. All are welcome!

## **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**

The Sunday following Easter Sunday is the Feast of the Divine Mercy named by Saint John Paul II at the canonization of St. Faustina on April 30, 2000.

The origins of the Divine Mercy date back to apparitions witnessed by St. Maria Faustina in the 1930s. St. Faustina was born Helena Kowalska, in Poland on August 25, 1905. As a small child she reported seeing bright lights during her night prayers. Though she wanted to enter into religious life, her father refused to give her permission citing she was too young. As a teenager she worked as a servant in a neighboring city. One day, at a local dance she had a vision that touched her heart and changed her life—she experienced a **profound** vision of Christ suffering. She left her job and in 1925 entered the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lord of Mercy taking the name Faustina. Though she was liked by the other sisters, they couldn't understand her visions and prophecies. On February 22, 1931 she experienced a new life-changing vision in which Christ wearing a white robe and raising his right hand in blessing, rested his left hand on his heart from which flowed two rays of light. Jesus told her, "Paint an image according to the pattern you see, with the prayer, Jesus, I trust in you." Though Faustina struggled to convince others of the authenticity of her vision, she ultimately persuaded her spiritual director that the vision was real. He found an artist to create the painting that was named The Divine Mercy which was displayed on April 28, 1935.

Sister Faustina devoted the rest of her life to spreading devotion to The Divine Mercy. Sister Faustina died at the age of 33 from tuberculosis. Her writings have been translated into many languages and continue to offer hope in God's endless mercy.
