

MOST HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY May 26, 2024

Most Holy Trinity Sunday is celebrated a week after Pentecost Sunday and honors the most fundamental of Christian beliefs – belief in the Holy Trinity. Though the human mind can never fully understand the mystery of the Trinity, it can be summed up as follows: *God is three Persons in one Nature*. *There is only one God and the three Persons of God (Father, Son, Holy Spirit) are all equally God and They cannot be divided*.

The origins of the celebration of Trinity Sunday go back to the Arian heresy of the 4th century. Arius, a Catholic priest, believed that Jesus Christ was a created being rather than God. Arius' chief opponent, Athanasius, upheld the orthodox doctrine that there are three Persons in one God, and the orthodox view prevailed at the Council of Nicaea, from which we get the Nicene Creed. It was established as a feast day in 1334 by Pope John XXII.
