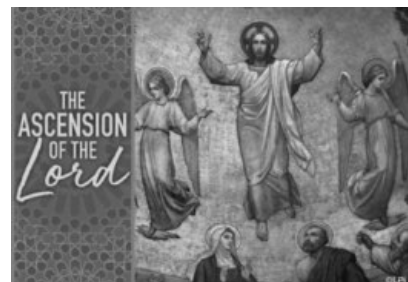
ASCENSION THURSDAY
MAY 9, 2024

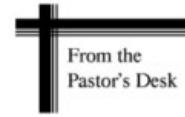
The 40th day after Easter Sunday commemorates the Ascension of Christ into heaven in the presence of His disciples at Mt. Olivet near Bethany. The observance of this feast is of great antiquity; St. Augustine says it is of Apostolic origin. Christ’s ascension shows us that His work on earth was completed. During His final appearance to His disciples, He promised to send a helper, the Holy Spirit. Then Jesus was taken up by a cloud into heaven.

Ascension Thursday is a day to celebrate Christ’s victory over sin and death. It’s a day filled with joy and hope that we will one day be resurrected and glorified like Christ.

Ascension Thursday is a Holy Day of Obligation for all Catholics to attend Mass. Masses will be celebrated on Wednesday, May 8th at 7:00 p.m. and Thursday, May 9th at 8:30 a.m.

Having just concluded our First Reconciliations for our children preparing for their First Eucharist, we reflect on the words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church that states, "Only God forgives sins. Since he is the Son of God, Jesus says of himself, "The Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" and exercises this divine power: "Your sins are forgiven." Further, by virtue of his divine authority he gives this power to men to exercise in his name (1441)." The catechism further reminds us that "Children must go to the sacrament of Penance before receiving Holy Communion for the first time." Therefore, as a parish and as a Faith Formation program we are grateful and joyful that our families have participated in seeking this sacrament for its forgiveness and love of our merciful God. Now we happily turn our attention to the glory of the Eucharist.

On May 7th, our Grade/Level 2 families are called to attend a First Holy Eucharist practice session in the Church. Reminders to be sent to families closer to the date of the practice.

On Saturday, May 11, our Academy children celebrate the sacrament of First Eucharist.

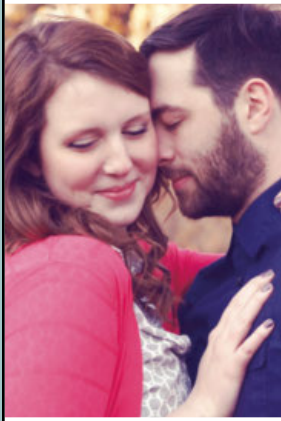

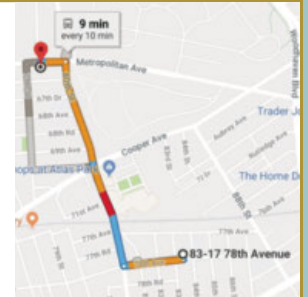
