




ASCENSION THURSDAY MAY 9, 2024

Having just concluded our First Reconciliations for our children preparing for their First Eucharist, we reflect on the words of the Catechism of the Catholic Church that states, "Only God forgives sins. Since he is the Son of God, Jesus says of himself, "The Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins" and exercises this divine power: "Your sins are forgiven." Further, by virtue of his divine authority he gives this power to men to exercise in his name (1441)." The catechism further reminds us that "Children must go to the sacrament of Penance before receiving Holy Communion for the first time." Therefore, as a parish and as a Faith Formation program we are grateful and joyful that our families have participated in seeking this sacrament for its forgiveness and love of our merciful God. 
