Faith Formation Corner

Did you know? As mentioned last week, the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage ended this past Sunday, July 21st. The pilgrimage was modeled after the Gospel account of Jesus' journey to Emmaus. The pilgrimage covered the U.S. from coast to coast for a combined distance of over 6,500 miles with stops along the way at many holy sites and shrines. A group of 24 individuals accompanied Jesus in the Eucharist for the full pilgrimage!

As a reminder, have your family participate in the Church's call to a Eucharistic Revival by taking the following steps: 1) Jesus told us, "This IS my body." He didn't say it represents, symbolizes or might be my body. Explain that the Eucharist is Jesus' body to your kids and that it's part of the Mystery of Faith! (Bl. Carlo Acutis created a Eucharistic Miracles database to help us with this belief.)

2) Offer something up! At Mass, during the offertory, place your intentions on the host as it becomes exposed. Do it again as you receive Jesus in the Eucharist since you are now literally standing before Him!

3) Go to Adoration! Don't have a lot of time? Pop into Sacred Heart, even if it's just for a few minutes with children and visit Jesus in the tabernacle. Help them understand that Jesus is in the tabernacle waiting for us to visit Him.

4) Increase personal reverence to the Eucharist. Others pick up on what we do including children so bowing anytime you pass the tabernacle and genuflecting when entering the pew are just some simple ways to show Jesus how special He is to us!

Meanwhile, registration for the 2024-2025 Sacred Heart Faith Formation school year continues. All children must have a copy of their baptismal certificate on file with our office in order to register into our program. Baptismal certificates are required at the time of all new registrations. Reminder! Summer office hours and coverage will be limited so it's best to contact us through email at info@sacredheartreligion.org for any questions or help.
