



The Grade/Level 7 confirmation interview schedule for our children in the Academy and Faith Formation program has been re-Talk FORMATION leased to all families. During the first week of June, our Grade/

Level 7 confirmation candidates should complete their Confirmation interviews (along with all of the Year 1 requirements) in order to continue with registration into Confirmation Preparation Year 2.

All Grade/Level 8 registrations must be completed by no later than June 30th in order to join us for Confirmation in 2026.

Meanwhile, an in-person registration period begins on Monday, June 9th through Thursday, June 12th in the Faith Formation office from 10 am through 3:30 pm. Additional dates/times will be released as needed. We remind all families joining our program that a copy of your child's baptismal certificate is required in order to join our program.

Students in Grades 1, 3-7 must have completed and passed all of their lessons and assessments in My Catholic Faith Delivered in order to register into the next grade level (all MCFD) coursework was to be completed by May 15th). Anyone not completing and passing all of their assessments will be invited to repeat their grade level. Report cards will be released during the month of June.
