



This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday! Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles of Jesus while they were in Jerusalem.

This past week our Grade/Level 7 confirmation candidates were interviewed in order to determine their readiness to pro-

ceed with Year 2 sacrament preparation. Candidates were interviewed by one of the following individuals: Fr. McBrien, Fr. Fullum, Mr. Stalzer (Grade 7 Catechist), Mrs. Czak (Catechist, Faith Formation Office) or myself (Mrs. Stalzer). We thank everyone for the help in conducting these interviews and for the students that prepared diligently and came ready for their meetings! Anyone not interviewed by June 30th will not be able to register into our Year 2 preparation. We remind all our Grade/Level 7 candidates that their Grade/Level 8 registration forms and fees must be submitted no later than June 30th in order to join us for Confirmation in 2026.

Students in Grades 1, 3-7 must have completed and passed all of their lessons and assessments in *My Catholic Faith Delivered* in order to register into the next grade level (all MCFD coursework was to be completed by <u>May 15th</u>). Anyone not completing and passing all of their assessments will be invited to repeat their grade level. Report cards are currently being issued.

Our in-person registration period begins on **Monday, June 9th through Thursday, June 12th** in the Faith Formation office from 10 am through 3:30 pm. Additional dates/times will be released as needed. We remind all families joining our program that a copy of your child's baptismal certificate is required in order to join our program. New Registrations must provide a copy of the child's baptismal certificate to enroll in our program. Any transfers into our program must provide a letter of transfer from their previous program. Any child re-registering in our program must have successfully completed their prior year's work.

We congratulate the individuals receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation on Pentecost this Sunday, June 8th at our 11:30 am Mass.

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (1076), the Church was made manifest to the world on the day of Pentecost by the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. The gift of the Holy Spirit brings in a new "age" in the Church during which Christ makes present and communicates his work of salvation through the liturgy of the Church. **He acts through the Sacraments of the Catholic Church!**




