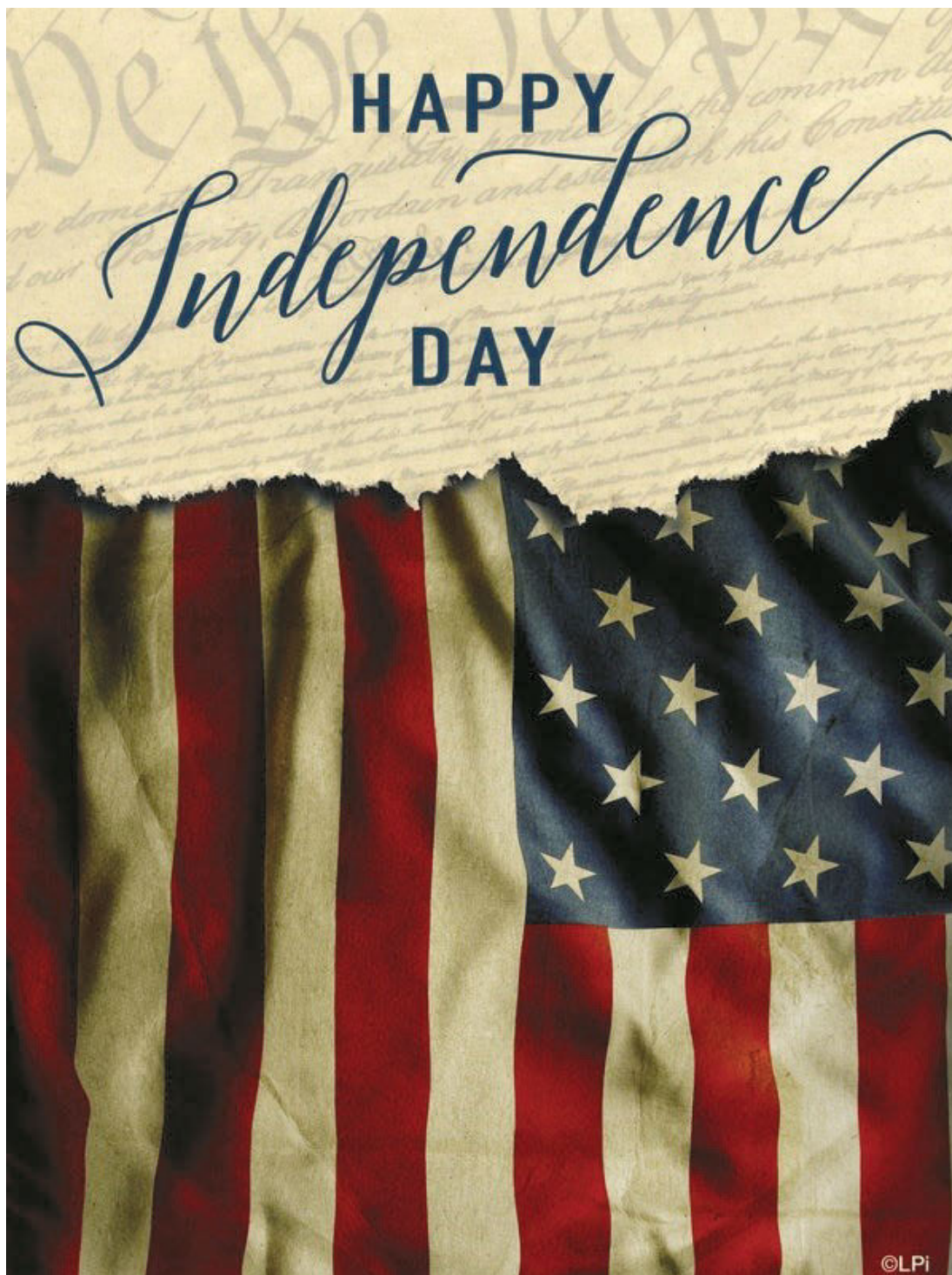

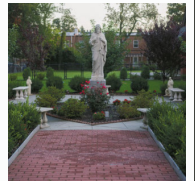

Sunday, June 29th is the feast day of Saints Peter & Paul. St. Peter was the first Pope. St. Paul converted to Christianity when on the way to Damascus he heard Our Lord's voice and was temporarily blinded. Afterwards he preached the Gospel converting many and performing miracles. It's believed that St. Paul was martyred on the same day as St. Peter, because St. Paul was a Roman citizen, he was beheaded instead of being crucified.

If Christ has not been raised our hope is in vain!

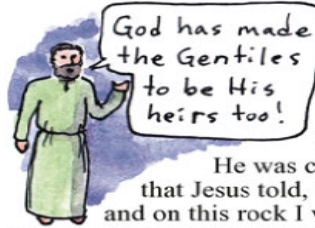
PAUL WROTE LETTERS TO THE NEW CHRISTIANS. MANY OF THESE ARE PART OF THE BIBLE.

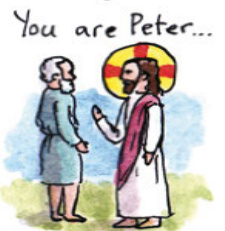

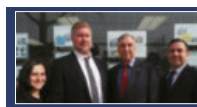

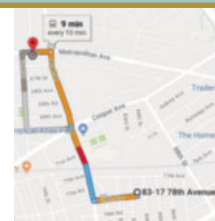
