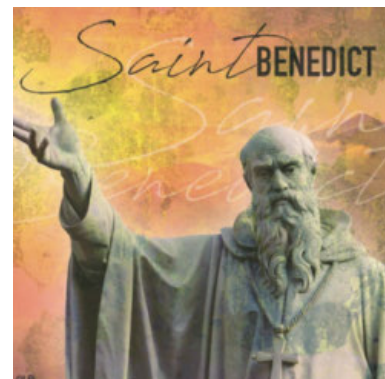
Attending Mass during the summer months helps children continue their spiritual formation so please don't neglect weekly Mass attendance.
