

Dear Parishioners,

In his first message on the "World Day of Prayer for Grandparents and the Elderly" Pope Leo XVI issued words of hope and comfort.

In excerpts from Catholic News Agency (CNA), the Holy Father spoke of the Jubilee Year of Hope stating "hope is a contact source of joy, whatever our age." He cited some elderly biblical figures, such as Abraham and Sarah, Moses and Zechariah, whom the Lord surprised in "an act of saving power." "God repeatedly demonstrates his providential care by turning to people in their later years."

"How often our grandparents have been for us examples of faith and devotion, civic virtue and social commitment, memory and perseverance amid trials! The precious legacy that they have handed down to us with hope and love will always be a source of gratitude and a summons to perseverance," he said.

In the context of the Jubilee Year, he invited the faithful to "to break through the barriers of indifference ..." and to give of themselves to prevent feelings of loneliness and abandonment among the elderly.

"Our societies, everywhere in the world, are growing all too accustomed to letting this significant and enriching part of their life be marginalized and forgotten," he lamented.

The pope also recalled the words of Pope Francis during his last hospitalization: "our bodies are weak, but even so, nothing can prevent us from loving, praying, giving ourselves, being there for one another, in faith, as shining signs of hope."

Pope Leo XIV also indicated that "affection for our loved ones – for the wife or husband with whom we have spent so much of our lives, for our children, for our grandchildren who brighten our days – does not fade when our strength wanes."

"Indeed, their own affection often revives our energy and brings us hope and comfort," he added.

"Let us lovingly pass on the faith we have lived for so many years, in our families and in our daily encounter with others. May we always praise God for his goodness, cultivate unity with our loved ones, open our hearts to those who are far away and, in particular, to all those in need. In this way, we will be signs of hope, whatever our age," the pope concluded.







*Did you know...*July 26th is the feast day of Saint Anne and Saint Joachim who were the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary. They are also Jesus's grandparents!

Tradition says that Joachim was very wealthy and generous. One day, Joachim wanted to make an offering at the temple which was rejected by a Levitical priest because Joachim was childless. Distressed, Joachim went to the desert praying and fasting for 40 days asking God for a child. Meanwhile Anne prayed for a child as well. Anne and Joachim had an angel appear to each of them telling them that God had heard their prayers and that they would conceive a child. Mary was born 9 months later. Because of a vow they had made to God, they brought Mary to the temple at age 3 where she remained until she was married. Mary became Jesus's mother. The birth of the Virgin Mary is traditionally celebrated on September 8th, nine months after the Feast of the Immaculate Conception on December 8th.

Saint Anne, Saint Joachim, patron saints of grandparents and the elderly, pray for us!


The Violinist: Stories of Solanus Casey


St. Alphonsus Liguori | Catholic Saints








Make sure you say the "Our Father' every day to praise God our Father and ask Him for everything you need.


