




VOLUNTEERS NEEDED




PRAYER PARTNER BOX



Did you know...August 15th is the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. On this day, we celebrate Mary's entry into Heaven at the end of her earthly life. The Church teaches that

Mary was taken up to Heaven both body and soul. The Church also teaches that when each one of us dies we will experience the separation of the body and soul but they will be reunited at the end of time. The Church teaches that because God preserved Mary from sin in order to be the Mother of Jesus, her body was taken up to Heaven immediately just as Jesus ascended body and soul to Heaven after the Resurrection. Meanwhile, the Eastern Catholic Church calls this feast the Dormition of the Most Holy Mother of God because Mary's death was like falling asleep.

Faith Formation Reminders:

Attending Mass during the summer months helps children continue their spiritual formation so please don't neglect weekly Mass attendance!




