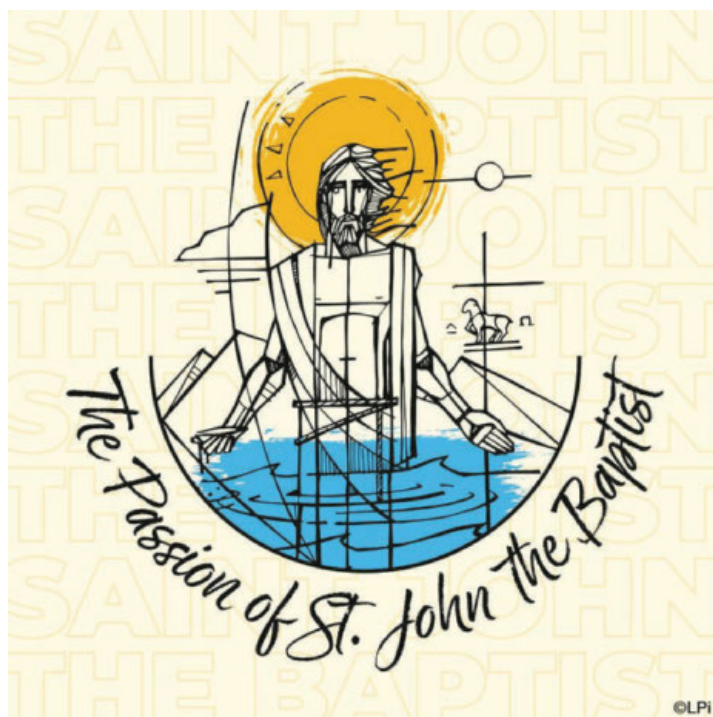

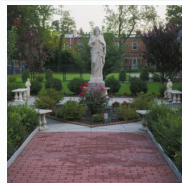

Did you know... August 25th we celebrate the feast day of Saint Louis of France. During his lifetime (in the 13th century), he was often called the "monk king" due to his obvious devotion to the faith.

He was cheerful and kind, as well as an accomplished knight in battle. He worked tirelessly to unite France. He also participated in the Crusades to regain Christian control of the Holy Land. His court in France was famous for hospitality and charity. Each day, the poor dined either inside or near his palace, and the King tended personally to the needs of lepers and beggars. Until he died, he tried to follow the advice that he gave his son, the future King of France: *Dear Son, let your heart be gentle, compassionate and charitable toward the poor, the feeble, the unfortunate, toward everyone you think to be suffering in mind or body. Maintain the good customs of your kingdom, suppress those which are bad. Do not covert your people's goods, and do not oppress them with duties or taxes.* (Saint Louis's "Testament")

Faith Formation Reminders:

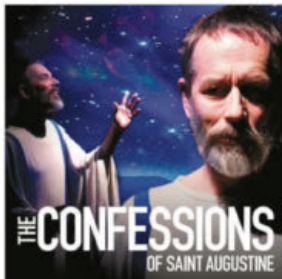
The Confessions of St. Augustine | Littlest Saints

The Confessions of Saint Augustine

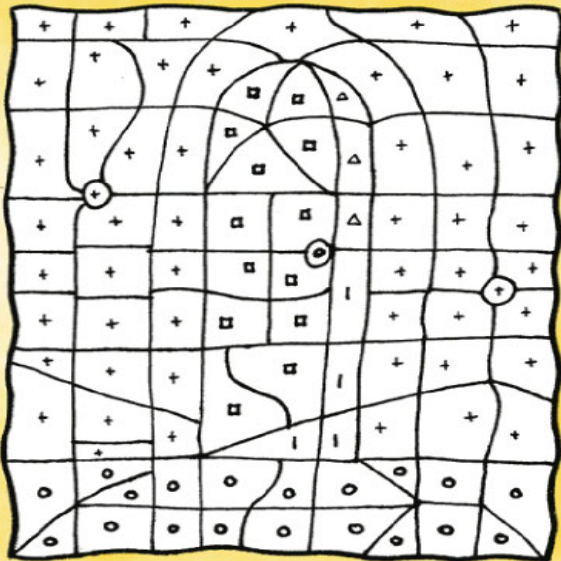

Being Punished...

In today's second reading, Saint Paul wrote to the Hebrews about being disciplined by God. When we are young God wants our parents to make sure we behave well. When we don't behave He wants them to discipline us so that we will learn to be good.



Our parents don't punish us just because they are angry at us; they do it because they really love us and want us to learn to be better. Saint Paul says that the Lord disciplines the people that He loves.



Being punished is a painful thing, but we will be happy once we have learned our lesson and become a better person. Saint Paul says, "make a straight path for your feet, so that what is lame may not be put out of joint but rather be healed." He means that

when you are punished, you should stop doing the wrong thing so that you won't be hurt worse from the punishment, but will get better instead. So the next time you are disciplined or punished, remember that God is allowing it to help you become a better person. If you can, even thank God for giving you the chance to make up for your sin and learn a good lesson!

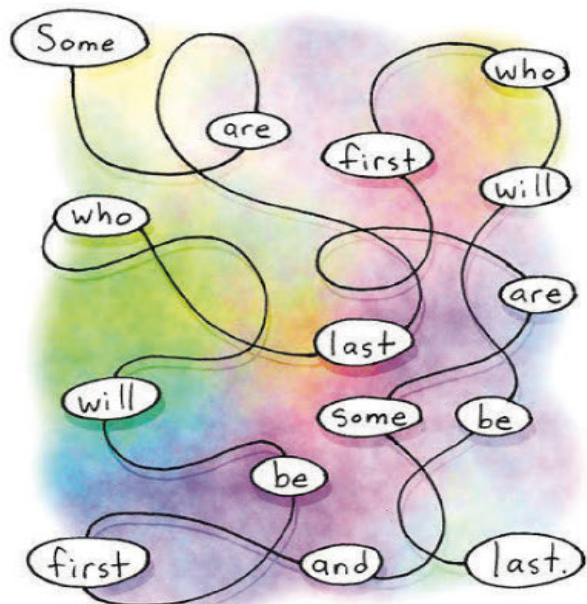

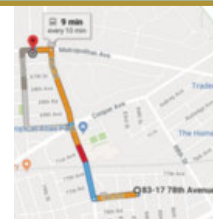
