September 14th is the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. In the year 326, Saint Helena, mother of Roman Emperor, Constantine, traveled to the Holy Land to order the construction of churches at all the important places in the life of Christ. While building a

Church where Jesus was crucified, the construction crew found the cross on which Jesus had died. Legend tells us that Helena proved it was the true Holy Cross because at the site of Christ's crucifixion, 3 crosses were unearthed. A terminally ill woman was brought to the site of the discovery and after touching the first 2 crosses, she remained ill. Touching the 3rd cross she was instantaneously healed. Sacred Heart Church is blessed to have a relic of the True Cross.

Faith Formation Updates



Today we celebrate the feast of the Exaltation, or Triumph, of the Holy Cross on which Our Lord died. The cross was an instrument of torture used to punish criminals and to show other people what would happen to them too, if they broke the Roman laws. Our Lord used the cross for a different reason though. He offered His sufferings on the cross to repay for the sins of everyone else in the world. He died in a place where many people could see Him so that they could see and know how much He loves us.

In the 300's AD, St. Helena, who was a Christian queen, went to Jerusalem to find the cross of Jesus. She found three crosses there so she decided to test to see which

was Christ's. A very sick woman touched each cross. When she touched the third one she was healed instantly! They had found the cross of Christ!



not a Christian yet, but when he was about to go to war he had a vision of the cross and heard the words "In this sign you shall conquer!" So he had crosses drawn on all the flags and shields, and he won the battle. Then he believed in Jesus and became a Christian.
