September 23rd is the feast day of St. Pius of Pietrelcina commonly known as Padre Pio (born Francesco). Padre Pio came from a poor farming family. As a child he loved going to church to visit Jesus. It was said that he could see

Guardian Angels! He joined the Capuchin friars and lived a life of prayer and sacrifice. He received the wounds of Jesus (the stigmata) on his hands and feet and spent many hours hearing confessions which brought many people closer to God. He taught people to "Pray, hope and don't worry."



We can also please God by giving money to the Church and the poor. He wants us to show that we can do well looking after small things like money so that He can trust us with bigger jobs.


