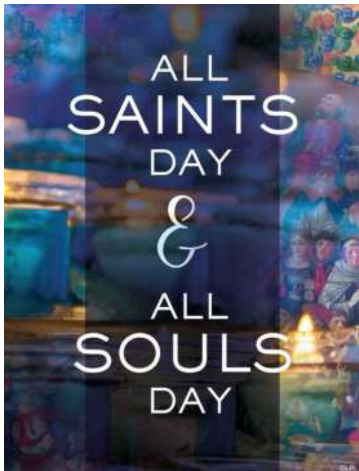
2nd ANNUAL DAFFODIL WEEKEND

There are two important feast days this weekend!

Saturday, November 1st is All Saints' Day! This is the day we remember and honor all the saints - those known and unknown to us. There are saints in heaven from every nation and social

class. There are many saints we know but also many that led holy, hidden lives. This can include the people in our own families due to their love of God and neighbor, persistence in trying to do good, and openness to God's help and will. The saints intercede on our behalf so let's not forget to ask for their intercession!

Sunday, November 2nd is All Souls' Day! This is a day to honor our family, friends, and even strangers who are no longer living.

Faith Formation Updates

This Sunday, November 2nd, Grade/Level 8 young disciples along with one parent are required to attend the 9:30 am Mass followed by the proximate preparation session, *Full of Grace*. The presentation will take place following the 9:30 am Mass in the Church basement. This is a mandatory event and attendance will be taken. Proximate preparation is required for all young disciples seeking the sacrament of confirmation in their Grade/Level 8 year.

Sunday, November 9th at 9:30 AM is our Grade/Level 1 Class Mass. Immediately following the Mass, our Grade/Level 1 young disciples should proceed to the Church basement (along with 1 parent) for a meeting with their catechist.

Sunday, November 9th at 9:30 am AM is also the CYO Mass. A special blessing will be offered to all the young athletes attending this special Mass along with a small gift of appreciation for all the young athletes attending this Mass.

Any Faith Formation or Academy child participating in our *My Sacred Heart Mass Attendance Passport* program is reminded to bring their passport to be stamped at the **end of each Sunday 9:30 am Mass**. This program applies only to the 9:30 am Mass. No passports will be stamped before, during or outside of Mass. Stamping will be done in the vestibule at the end of Mass (only after the Priest processes out at the end of Mass).

*Eternal rest
grant unto
him, O Lord.*



When people die, their souls go either to Heaven or Hell- if they loved God they will go to Heaven, and if they chose not to love God then they will go to Hell. But some people love God and still do sins. Their souls are dirty with the stain of sin, but they did not choose to reject God altogether. Those souls need to be cleaned before they can go into Heaven.

Purgatory is the place where the souls go who are not clean enough to go straight to Heaven. They have to wait until they have suffered enough to make up for their sins.



Probably most people we know who have died are in Purgatory. We should pray for them whenever we think of them- if we see a picture of them, or hear someone talking about them, or if we hear of someone who just died.

God will hear our prayers and accept the sacrifices we make for the holy souls so that they can go to Heaven sooner. Do you think they will pray for us when they get there?

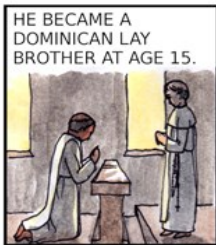

As GOLD in the FURNACE, he proved them, and as sacrificial OFFERINGS he TOOK them to himself.

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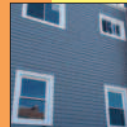
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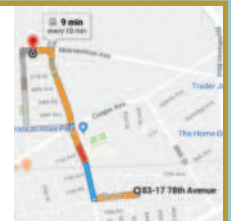
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
