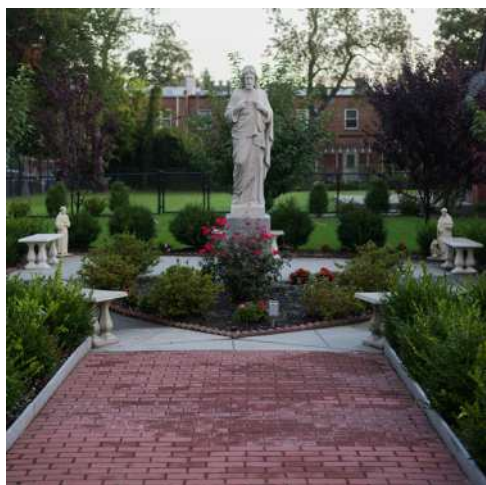

## THIRD SUNDAY

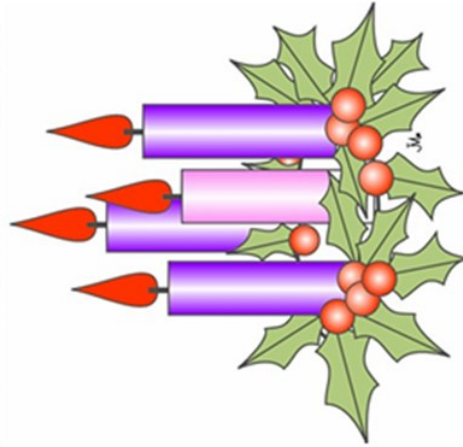

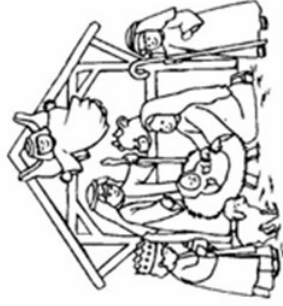
## SECOND SUNDAY

This Sunday, November 30th is the first Sunday of Advent! Today many of our children and families will join us to create Advent wreaths and enjoy some time together to begin the season of Advent. Each Sunday during the Advent season we will light a candle - one for each week of the season - to mark the

moments of Advent. Three purple candles and one rose candle will be lit. The purple candles represent the prayer, penance and charitable works we do during this season. The rose candle means rejoice and marks the halfway point until Christ's birth at Christmas. The lighting of the candles symbolizes the hope of the first coming of Jesus into the world and the anticipation of his second coming at the end of time.

### Faith Formation Updates

Also, **Sunday, December 7th at 9:30 AM** is our Grade 5 Class Mass followed by a meeting for the students and parents in the church basement.

**Monday, December 8th**, we celebrate the **Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception** which is our Church's belief that Mary, from the first moment of her conception, was free from all sin and stain of sin. **This feast is a holy day of obligation!**

**Wednesday, December 10th** at 7 PM in Church is our Grade/Level 8 Proximate Preparation Meeting on the topic of Vocations. We welcome Fr. Chris Bethge and the Little Sisters of the Poor who join our students and parents to discuss this important topic. Attendance is **mandatory** and will be taken.

Advent confessions for Faith Formation Grades 7 and 8 will be held on **Saturday, December 13th** at 1 PM in the Church.

Grade/Level 8 confirmation packets are due by no later than Sunday, December 14th! Bring your yellow forms to this Grade 8 class mass at 9:30 AM.

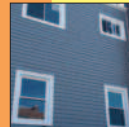

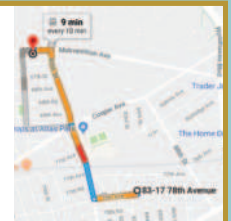
