



On December 8th, the Church celebrates the Immaculate Conception. In 1854 the Catholic Church affirmed the belief that Mary was granted a specific grace; Mary was preserved FORMATION from Original Sin by the effect of Jesus's own death and resurrection. One

of Mary's titles is the New Eve. With her YES to God, she brings Jesus (the new Adam) to the world to heal it from sin. Throughout her life, Mary preserved her sinless nature by always doing God's will. Mary used her freedom to always choose what is good.

"As soon as she [Mary] had the use of reason, that is, from the first moment of her immaculate conception in the womb of Saint Ann, from that time she began with all her powers to love her God; and thus she continued to do, ever advancing more in perfection and love through her whole life. All her thoughts, her desires, her affections, were wholly given to God; not a word, not a motion, not a glance of the eye, not a breath of hers that was not for God and for his glory, never departing one step, nor separating herself for one moment from the divine love." - Saint Alphonsus Liguori



















