Today we celebrate the third Sunday of Advent known as Gaudete (Latin meaning: Rejoice!) Sunday. Its name is taken from the entrance antiphon of the Mass, which is:

Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Indeed, the Lord is near.

On the 3rd Sunday of Advent we light the rose-colored candle. This signifies joy and the half-way point of the Advent season. Advent is the season of preparing for the arrival of the Lord Jesus (both his first coming and his second coming).

On December 13th, we celebrate St. Lucy (patron of eyes). Sacred Heart has a beautiful statue of St. Lucy in our Saints alcove. According to legend, St. Lucy's countrymen were starving. She prayed with them for help. As they prayed, a ship arrived in the harbor carrying enough wheat for all. (The name Lucy comes from the Latin Lucia meaning light).
